

Lăcrămioara Perju-Dumbravă, MD, PhD is Associate Professor of neurology, doctorate coordinator within the Neurosciences Department, Faculty of Medicine, University of Medicine and Pharmacy “Iuliu Hatieganu” Cluj-Napoca and physician neurologist in the First Neurology University Clinic, County Emergency Clinical Hospital Cluj-Napoca, Romania. Among the multiple internships/training courses graduated over time, it is worth mentioning: postgraduate training at the University of Medicine in Vienna - completed with the "Diploma in Neurology" issued by the University of Vienna/Austria, advanced training at the Neurology Clinic, Grenoble University Hospital/France and postgraduate course in palliative care at University of Dundee/UK - completed with "Certificate of Competence in Palliative Care". Currently, Professor Lăcrămioara Perju-Dumbravă, is member of the Board of Directors in the Romanian Society of Neurology and Romanian official delegate in UEMS – EBN (Board of Neurology) where she also holds the position of treasurer.
